A small, round light bread that fell like rain on each morning except the Sabbath.

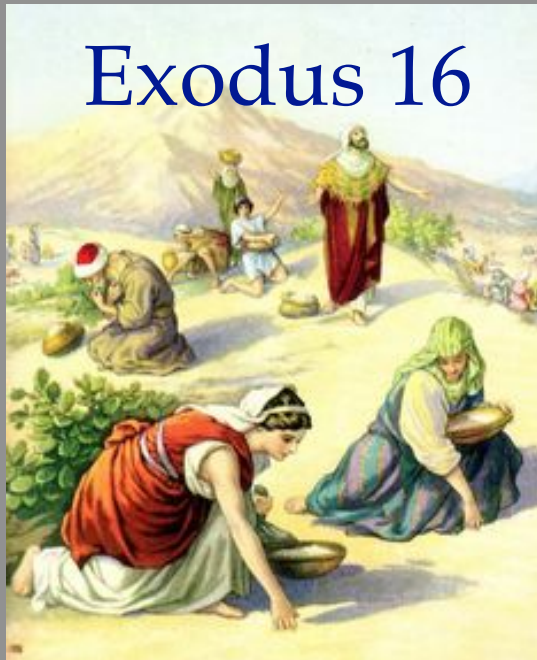
Historical Summary
